CHOOSE TO REUSE!

This Reuse Directory is a tool to help people who have materials to donate find organizations that accept those materials for reuse (and sometimes recycling). This directory focuses mostly on nonprofit organizations that use donated materials to supply people with resources they might not otherwise be able to obtain.

Baltimore County promotes reuse because it has many advantages over throwing things away.

BY DONATING REUSABLE ITEMS, YOU WILL:

- Help other people and organizations.
- Reduce disposal costs.
- Preserve landfill space.
- Conserve natural resources.
- Reduce air and water pollution.

You may also qualify for valuable tax deductions when you donate certain items.

Whether you are cleaning out your house or simply replacing an old item with a new one, remember to check this directory and REUSE!

ABOUT THIS DIRECTORY

The Baltimore County Bureau of Solid Waste Management publishes the Reuse Directory to make it easier for you to donate unwanted items. While we have taken great care to ensure this directory is thorough and accurate, it is strongly suggested that you call an organization before bringing materials to its site. An organization's needs, hours and locations often change over time.

HOW TO USE THIS DIRECTORY

The Reuse Directory has two main sections: the Materials Index and the Organizations Index. Use both references to find the reuse organizations that are best for you.

- **CHECK THE MATERIALS INDEX**

Review the Materials Index on pages 5–16 for an alphabetical listing of materials that can be reused. Under each material is a list of the of organizations that use them.

- **CHOOSE AN ORGANIZATION**

There may be several options for reusing a particular item. Check the Organizations Index on pages 17–53 for details to help you decide which organization to choose. This index lists organizations alphabetically, providing addresses, contact names (when given), phone numbers, materials accepted and details about how to donate.

- **REVIEW PROCEDURES & ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

Most organizations have drop-off procedures and some offer pick-up services. Some organizations will accept broken items and repair them. Organizations may have restrictions that may or may not be listed in the Organizations Index. **It is always a good idea to call and verify that donations are being accepted, what can be donated and if there are any restrictions.**

BEYOND THIS DIRECTORY

Reuse is not a new idea. People have always handed down and given away useful items. Beyond sharing with friends and family and donating to charities, people have relied on established businesses that specialize in reuse.

Examples include rental centers, thrift stores and repair shops. Perhaps a repair shop can fix your broken sewing machine, television or other appliance. Repairing an item often costs less than replacing it. And remember, buying durable products that need fewer repairs will probably save you money in the long run.

Check your phone book under “Appliances” (repair and rental), “Rental” and “Thrift Shops” for reuse businesses near you. Newspaper classifieds, the Pennysaver, auctions, flea markets and yard sales are also great resources for buying and selling reusable goods. Websites and mobile apps such as Facebook Marketplace, Craigslist.org and OfferUp also provide opportunities to buy and sell reusables.

Other options for reuse include materials exchanges such as swapmamas.com, swapstyle.com, swap.com, trashnothing.com, paperbackswap.com and freecycle.org. These online materials exchanges give users the opportunity to swap, donate and/or obtain items.

For materials that cannot be reused and are difficult to recycle (including certain household batteries and textiles), check out the recycling directory at mdrecycles.org. There you can find listings of organizations that accept various materials not recycled by Baltimore County.
