

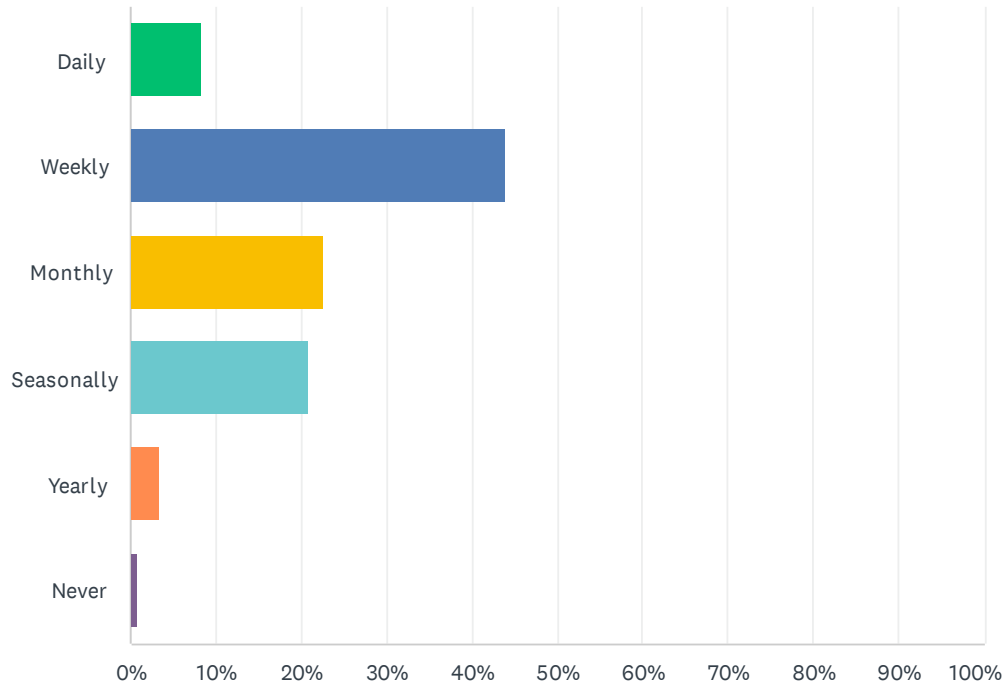

Q1 How often do you visit Oregon Ridge Park?

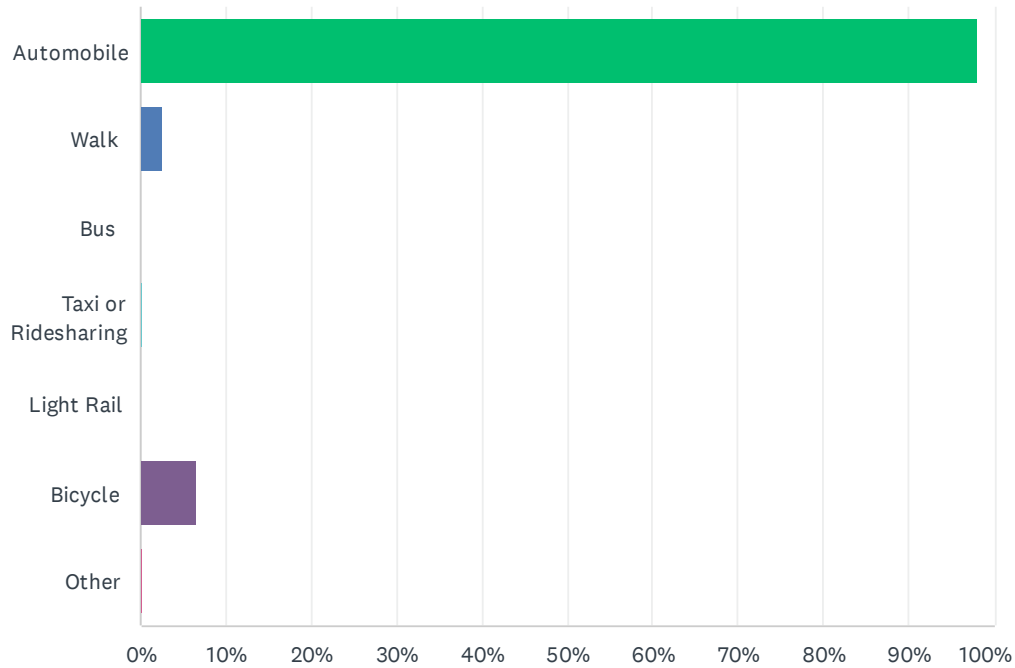

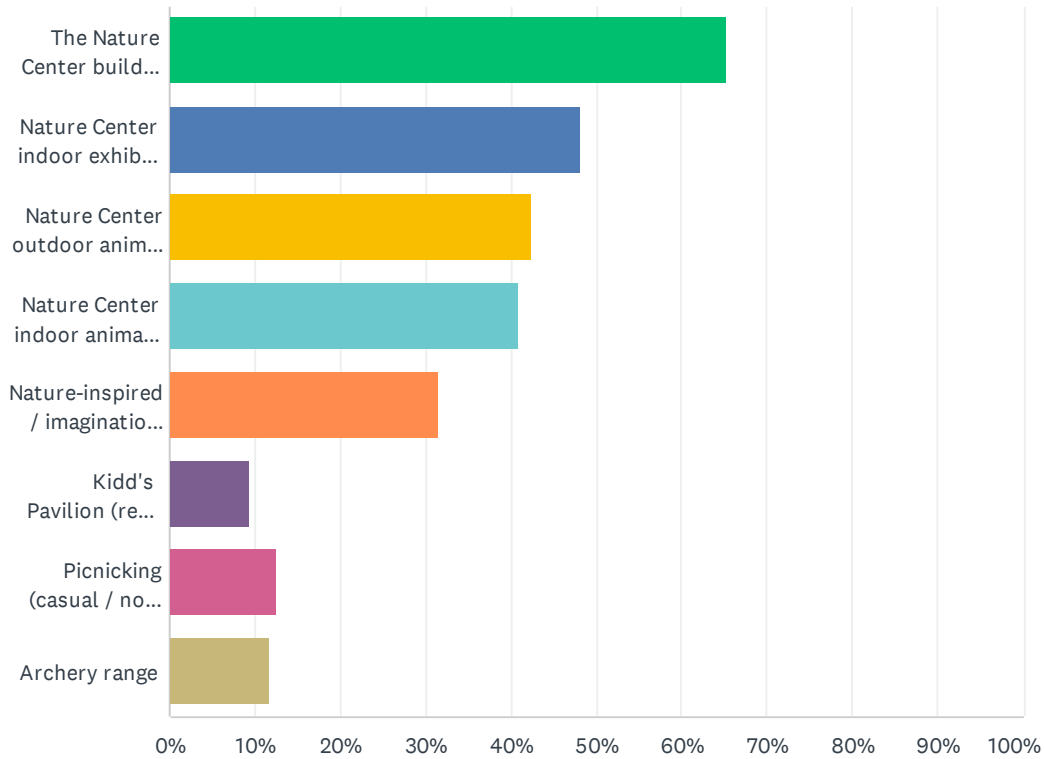

Q11 Which park features should be enhanced or upgraded at the Nature Center Area? (Select no more than three features.)

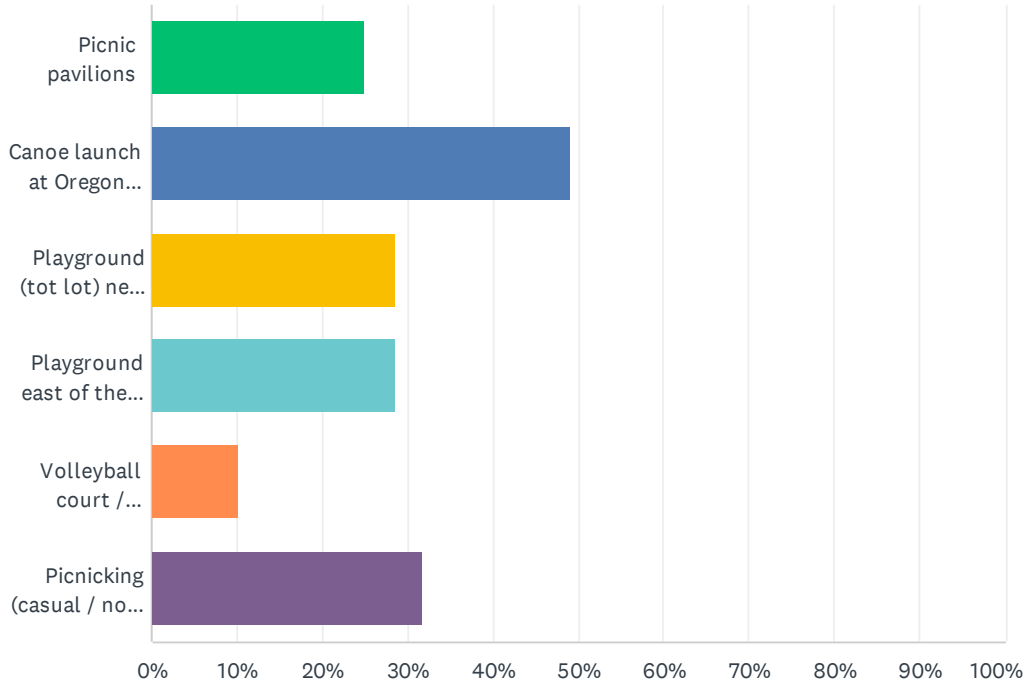

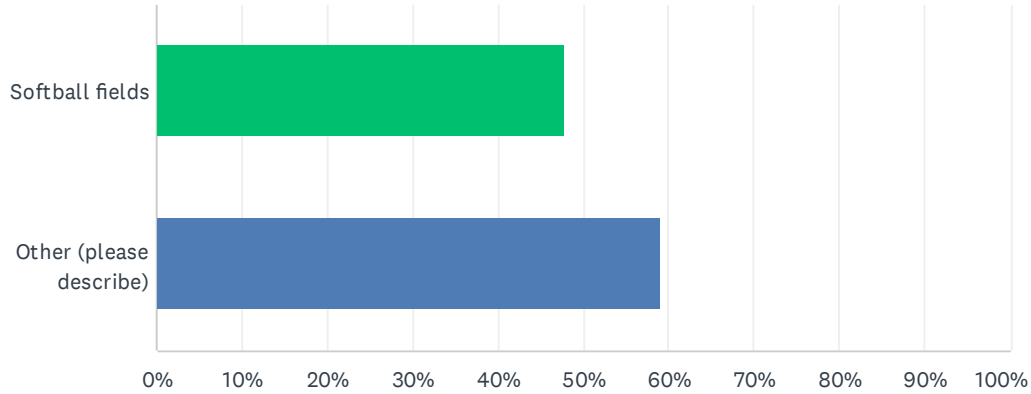

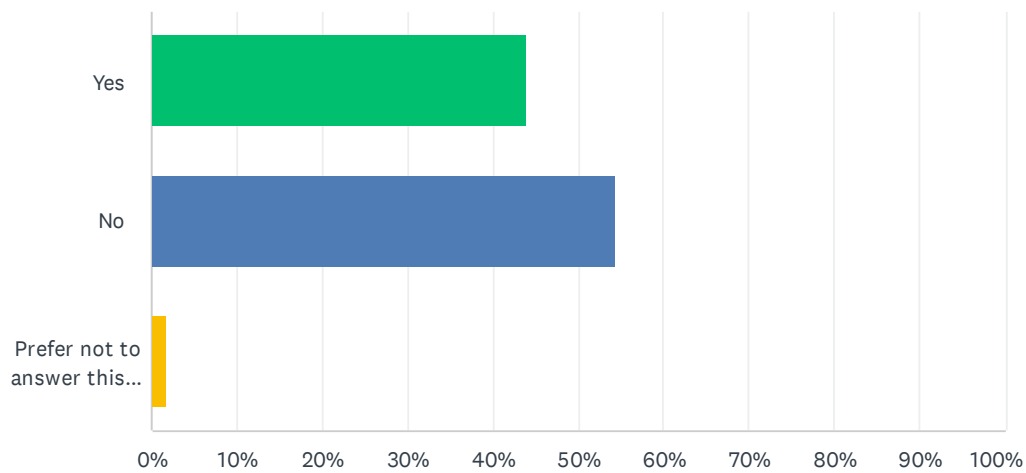

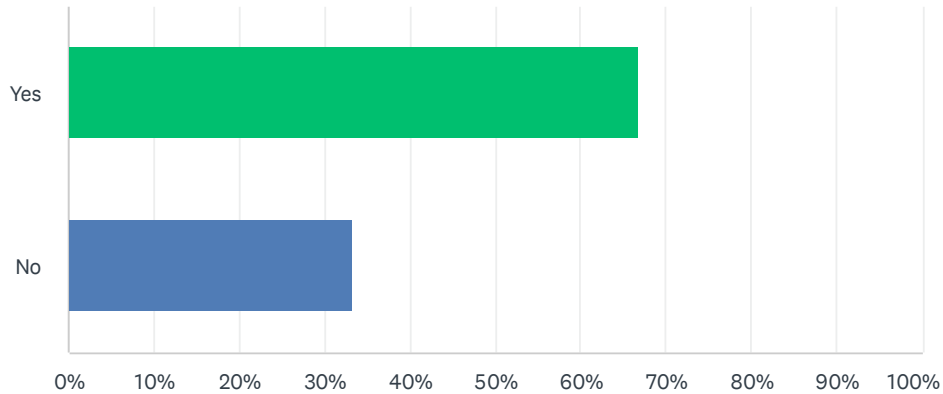
