

FROM THE CIRCUIT COURT
LEAD JUDGE – CRIMINAL

Effective immediately, in the event of a court closure due to inclement weather, all video bench warrant, bail reviews, and habeas corpus hearings will be heard the next business day. If the closure is on a Monday, any video arraignments and afternoon juvenile transfer status conferences will be carried over until the following Tuesday, or the next day that courts are opened, even if delayed. In the event of a delayed opening, generally all video hearings will be heard upon court opening.
