Judicial Review Notes

The attached form may be used to begin judicial review, or “appeal,” of the final decision of many state administrative agencies. The included notes are meant to provide the petitioner with highlights of the major steps for which they are responsible. Not every detail is mentioned.

This form is only intended for reviews conducted under chapter 200 of Maryland Rules, Title 7. If you are unsure if this applies to your situation, please check with an attorney who can help you.

PLEASE NOTE: These instructions and the included sample form are provided for your convenience. They are not official forms offered by the Maryland Judiciary. Highlights for the Petitioner Filing Under Title 7, Chapter 200 of the Maryland Rules

- Petitioner files for Judicial Review (Rule 7-202)
- If the review is of a Workers’ Compensation Commission’s (WCC) decision, then attach additional documents as necessary. (Rule 7-202(c)(2))
- For WCC decisions to be reviewed, the Petitioner must serve:
 - Workers’ Compensation Commission
 - Attorney General (if appropriate)
- Motion for a stay if desired. Stays are NOT automatic upon filing a petition for judicial review. (Rule 7-205)
- Most reviews are “on the record” meaning from the existing documents of the case used in the agency hearing(s). **Petitioner must gather the appropriate records.** If transcription of any record is needed, then the **petitioner may have to pay for it.** (Rule 7-206)
- Special steps for Workers’ Compensation Commission reviews. (Rule 7-206.1)
- Petitioner files a Memorandum if the review is on the record.(Rule 7-207)
 - The Memorandum is Petitioner’s legal argument.
 - The Library recommends reading *Principles and Practice of Maryland Administrative Law* by Arnold Rochvarg for further information on standards of review.
- Rule specific to hearings in Judicial Review cases (Rule 7-208)
- Possible dispositions by the court (Rule 7-209):
 - dismiss the action for judicial review or
 - May
 - affirm,
 - reverse,
 - modify the agency's order or action,
 - remand the action to the agency for further proceedings, or
 - an appropriate combination of the above.
- Request for impleader of the subsequent injury fund. (Rule 7-211)

SPECIAL STEPS FOR WORKER'S COMPENSATION DECISIONS:

If the review sought is of a decision of the Workers' Compensation Commission, state whether any issue is to be reviewed on the record before the Commission and, if it is, identify the issue and attach to the petition: a certificate that copies of the petition and attachments were served pursuant to subsection (d)(2) of Rule 7-202, and if no issue is to be reviewed on the record before the Commission, copies of the employee claim form and all of the Commission's orders in the petitioner's case.
