A BILL  
ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Property Tax Credits – Disabled Law Enforcement Officers

FOR the purpose of expanding a property tax credit for disabled Baltimore County law enforcement officers to a ~~law enforcement officer that was disabled through employment in the State~~ Maryland State Trooper; and generally relating to property tax credits.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

Section 11-2-109.1(a)(3)  
Article 11 – Taxation  
Title 2 – Ad Valorem Taxes  
Subtitle 2 – In General  
Baltimore County Code, 2015

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE  
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County read as follows:

5 § 11-2-109.1. Property tax credit for disabled law enforcement officers or rescue workers.

6 (a) (3) (i) “Disabled worker” means a MARYLAND STATE TROOPER OR A  
7 [Baltimore County] law enforcement officer or rescue worker who:

8 1. Has been found to be permanently and totally disabled by an  
9 administrative body or court of competent jurisdiction authorized to make such a determination;  
10 and

11 2. Became disabled:

12 A. As a result of or in the course of employment ~~IN THE~~  
13 ~~STATE~~ as a MARYLAND STATE TROOPER OR A [Baltimore County] law enforcement  
14 officer; or

15 B. While in the active service of a Baltimore County fire,  
16 rescue, or emergency medical service.

17 (ii) “Disabled worker” does not include:

18 A. a law enforcement officer or rescue worker whose  
19 disability was the result of the individual’s own willful misconduct or abuse of alcohol or drugs;  
20 OR

21 B. A MARYLAND STATE TROOPER WHO DID NOT  
22 SERVE AT LEAST ONE YEAR AT A MARYLAND STATE POLICE BARRACKS IN  
23 BALTIMORE COUNTY.

2           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by  
3 the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect ~~14 days from the~~  
4 ~~date of its enactment~~ JULY 1, 2025.
