TONIGHT'S AUGUST 7, 2023 COUNCIL LEGISLATIVE SESSION WILL BE HELD VIRTUALLY

Towson, MD – Baltimore County Council Chairman Julian E. Jones, Jr. (D, 4th) announced today that, after consultation with the County's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management and being notified of potentially severe weather in the Baltimore area, the County Council's Legislative Session scheduled for this evening, August 7, 2023 at 6:00 p.m., will be held virtually via WebEx teleconference rather than in-person.

County Government already announced the implementation of a liberal leave policy for all non-emergency/non-essential personnel effective 3:30 p.m. today, and beginning at 5:00 p.m. all in-person general Baltimore County government activities will be cancelled this evening.
