**APFO TASK FORCE SEEKS PUBLIC INPUT REGARDING SCHOOL
OVERCROWDING DEVELOPMENT LAW**
Public Hearing to Convene Virtually on Wednesday, December 16, 2020 at 4:00 p.m.

Towson, MD – The Baltimore County Adequate Public Facilities Ordinance (APFO) Task Force, which the County Council created through passage of Resolution 76-20 on August 3rd, is currently studying and evaluating methods to make significant improvement to the Baltimore County APFO as it relates to development and the need for adequate infrastructure and public school facilities. In order to ensure that it considers all pertinent issues from throughout the County regarding the functioning of the County’s current “school capacity” APFO law, the Task Force is seeking public input at a (virtual) public hearing, via WebEx, on **Wednesday, December 16, 2020 at 4:00 p.m.** (Please visit the Council’s “Virtual Meetings” page at <https://www.baltimorecountymd.gov/countycouncil/virtualmeetings.html> to register to testify on the day of the Public Hearing).
