A. Blakely electronically shared the Maryland Department of Health's Child Deaths by Drowning, 2010-2019 Data Brief and Child Abuse or Neglect 2010-2019 Data Brief prior to this month's CFRT meeting. Due to meeting time constraints, these reports were not reviewed at the meeting but summary information was sent through email after the meeting. Baltimore County CFRT was encouraged to keep this data in mind when developing public health efforts around reducing drowning deaths and child abuse or neglect incidence.
