

## **Quarterly Report**

January 1, 2019 Through March 31, 2019 Pursuant to Paragraph 19 of the Consent Decree between Baltimore County (County) and The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the Department of Justice (DOJ), and the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE), this document constitutes the required Quarterly Report for the period <u>January 1, 2019</u> through <u>March 31, 2019</u>.

The quarterly report discusses activities and progress of Baltimore County during the last quarter towards compliance with the requirements set forth in the Consent Decree including:

- i. Non-Pump Station and Pump Station SSO Structure discharges
- ii. Construction Project Status
- iii. Collection system inspection progress
- iv. SRRR plan implementation progress
- v. FOG program modification and development progress
- vi. Supplemental Environmental Projects status, and
- vii. Compliance with certification of completion and other issues of the Consent Decree

#### i(a). Non-Pump Station and Pump Station SSO Structure Discharges

Discharges from Sanitary Sewer Overflow Structures took place at the locations and dates during the reporting period as detailed in **Attachment A**.

A summary of flow metering information for Non-Pump Station SSO Structures is included as **Attachment A1.** 

#### ii. Construction Project Status

**Attachment B** presents the status of Paragraph 7 – Non-Pump Station SSO Structure Elimination projects and Paragraph 13.F - Pump Station Rehabilitation Repair and Replacement projects that are in construction during the reporting quarter.

#### iii. Collection System Inspection

Continued implementation of the inspection of the collection system, pursuant to Paragraphs 8 and 15 of the Consent Decree.

Paragraph 15.B.i.b inspections status is summarized in Attachment C; 0.3 miles were inspected attempted to be inspected during the reporting period with 12 manholes and other appurtenances also inspected attempted to be inspected. Baltimore County anticipates completing inspection of the gravity sewer lines identified in Paragraph 15.B.i.b by September 20, 2020.

Continued compliance with all gravity line CCTV inspections within the required 10 working days of the occurrence of an overflow for each SSO that occurred during this reporting period. **Attachment D** details the County's inspection response to each of the overflow that occurred during the reporting period.



#### iv. SRRR Plans

#### **SRRR Plan Implementation/Progress:**

The SRRR Plans contain numerous projects in a variety of locations and stages of planning, design and construction. **Attachment E** includes a list of each sewershed and a summary status of Plan implementation. The implementation of the recommended improvement projects is proceeding; however, acquisition of required rights-of-way and regulatory permits may require a significant period of time thereby resulting in possible delay to complete the construction work.

The County's recommendations in some of the SRRR Plans for meter basins that exhibited excessive I/I and design-storm simulated model-predicted SSOs included the comprehensive rehabilitation of all pipe segments and manholes, increased hydraulic capacity and/or testing and repair of sewer house connections and laterals. Some of the recommended repairs were revised based on design preparation and review of improvement projects. Additionally, some miscellaneous sewer/manhole/lateral repairs that were included in the SRRR Plans may be revised based on a review of the original and updated inspection data.

#### v. FOG Program

The County has completed implementation of the FOG Program Modification Plan.

(c) Problems that may prevent the County from meeting future Consent Decree compliance deadlines:

#### Cockeysville SRRR Plan

On 3/15/2019 the County submitted a potential delay notification for sewer structural repair and rehabilitation projects.

#### Bird River SRRR Plan



On 3/15/2019 the County submitted a potential delay notification for sewer structural repair and rehabilitation projects.

#### Bengies SRRR Plan

On 3/15/2019 the County submitted a potential delay notification for sewer structural repair and rehabilitation projects.

#### Elimination of Non-Pump Station SSO Structures 22, 23A, 23B, 24

To expedite completion of the downstream hydraulic improvements, the County has split the design project into two projects: Powder Mill Interceptor Relief Sewer Phase I and Phase II. The County is preparing final design documents for the first project and is awaiting City permits for the second design project. The first design project is anticipated to be advertised in the first half of 2019.

#### Elimination of Non-Pump Station SSO Structures 41 and 129

The County is continuing negotiations and finalizing easement agreements with four property owners to accommodate construction of the East Branch Herring Run Relief Sewer (reference potential delay notification dated March 3, 2017).

#### Elimination of Non-Pump Station SSO Structures 113, 116, 117 and 118

The County continues coordinating with the City to complete the needed hydraulic improvements to the City's collection system. The County and City engineering staff did not have a coordination meeting during the reporting period; however, the DPW directors met to discuss ways to better collaborate. All County and City data requests were addressed during the period. The County intends to meet with the City to discuss potential options to expedite the City's hydraulic improvement project(s) and expand their study area for a more regional approach.
