BY AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE SIGNING THIS PERMIT, PERMITTEE EXPRESSLY AGREES TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- Notify Inspector twenty-four (24) hours prior to beginning construction by fax (410) 887-5656 or phone (410) 887-4306. Permit expires one (1) year from date of issue.
- All work permitted shall be according to the Baltimore County Department of Public Works Standard Specifications for Construction and Materials dated February 2000, Addendum dated October 11, 2013, and Standard Details for Construction dated 2007.
- Pedestrian and Vehicular traffic must be protected at all times according to Section 104 of the Baltimore County 2000 Specifications. Work zone traffic shall conform to MD SHA traffic control typicals. A single lane of traffic is required to be maintained at all times.
- Permittee is responsible for identification and protection of all existing utilities i.e., sewer, water, and storm drains. Maintain a minimum of one (1) foot vertical clearance and five (5) foot horizontal clearance. It is the Permittees responsibility to contact Engineering Records at engrec@baltimorecountymd.gov or (410) 887-3758 to obtain "As Built" roadway drawings.
- The permittee is required to contact the Baltimore County Signal Shop at (410) 887-8601 to request clearances and marking of underground utilities located in the area of signalized intersections at least two (2) weeks prior to starting any work within 250 feet of the intersection.
- All contractors and subcontractors working on behalf of Permittee shall be prequalified by Baltimore County, following the requirements according to Construction Contracts Contractor Prequalification at <https://www.baltimorecountymd.gov/departments/publicworks/engineering/contracts/pwcontractsprequal.html>.
- Permittee shall protect, hold free and harmless, defend and indemnify Baltimore County: (including its Officers, Agents and Employees) from all liability, losses, damage, expenses, causes of action, claims or judgments resulting from injury to, or death of, any person or damage to property of any kind, which injury, death or damage arised out of, or is in any way connected with the performance of work under this permit; except that this agreement shall not be applicable to injury, death or damage to property arising from the sole negligence of Baltimore County, its Officers, Agents and Employees.
